ENGINEERING & ARCHITECTURE Journey to St. Louis

Would you like to show your students a thousand-year-old pyramid? Maybe the largest collection of mosaics in the world? A pure modern monument? Show your students how people have built amazing structures out of steel, brick, stone, wood, & even simply dirt.

Included: museums, guides, hotels, 3 meals daily, travel insurance.

Not Included: Meals while in transit, transportation and parking fees.

Program: Sites are in St. Louis and nearby towns. Included are:

- Cahokia Mounds, ruins of a thousand-year-old city
- The Gateway Arch, one of the most iconic modern structures
- St. Louis Basilica Cathedral, adorned with mosaics and dome
- The St. Louis City Museum, a great conversion of factory space
- French colonial homes from the late 1700's
- Stone homes from the mid-1800's, built by German immigrants
- Brick homes & buildings from the late 1800's & early 1900's

Justice: In addition to looking at buildings and structures, your students will go deeper in the city that launched the *Black Lives Matter* movement. You will visit the site of the Dred Scott case, and the site of Michael Brown's death in Ferguson. Your students will examine the impact of segregation, integration, and gentrification.

Lodging: Shared rooms at a 3-star or better hotel.

Meals: Meals will be in restaurants and the hotel, on a moderate budget, but still enjoying some local favorites.

Charity: *Saint Christopher Journeys* donates 10% of the fees paid by participants to local charities in the communities visited.














How is Saint Christopher Journeys different from other travel organizations? The purpose of Saint Christopher Journeys is: *Educational Travel Focusing on Justice through a Catholic Lens*. On a Saint Christopher Journey, you will visit museums and shrines, just like you would with another organization. You will *also* visit Catholic schools, orphanages, refugee shelters, hospitals, and other social services doing justice in their communities. Your group will be provided with resources for reflection and social analysis informed by philosophical concepts of social justice and *Catholic Social Teaching*. In short, on a Saint Christopher Journey, you go deeper.

Saint Christopher Journeys are restricted to adults 18 and older who are legally self-responsible. Journeys do involve walking on unpaved paths, using stairs, long rides and flights, limited menus, and not always with air conditioning. Adults need to keep these things in mind before choosing to make a journey.
