The journey will be led by Danielle Harrison, Manager of the Saint Charles Lwanaga Center. The group will depart Saint Louis at 6am on Monday, Oct 20 on a comfortable Vandalia bus. The group will return approximately 9:30pm on Thursday, Oct 23.

Included: Hotels, 3 breakfasts and 3 dinners, ground transportation from Saint Louis, tip for driver, museums, guides, speakers, travel insurance (Travel Guard Essential). **Not Included:** lunches, 1 dinner, hotel tips.

Clarksdale and Arkansas: A celebration of Mississippi Delta culture. Learn about the history of sharecropping and enjoy the Blues over dinner.

Philadelphia, Mississippi: A visit with the Choctaw community will enlighten travelers on their rich culture and the impact of the Trail of Tears.

Selma and Birmingham: The Civil Rights Era comes alive through museums, monuments, and speakers.

Nashville: The city where the 19th Amendment was ratified, giving women the right to vote.

Housing: Simple hotels with good on-line reviews will be used, two persons in each room. Single room is +\$210 total.

How is Saint Christopher Journeys different from other travel organizations? The purpose of Saint Christopher Journeys is: *Educational Travel Focusing on Justice through a Catholic Lens*. On a Saint Christopher Journey, you will visit museums and shrines, just like you would with another organization. You will *also* visit Catholic schools, orphanages, refugee shelters, hospitals, and other social services doing justice in their communities. Your group will be provided with resources for reflection and social analysis informed by philosophical concepts of social justice and *Catholic Social Teaching*. In short, on a Saint Christopher Journey, you go deeper.

Saint Christopher Journeys are restricted to adults 18 and older who are legally self-responsible. Journeys do involve walking on unpaved paths, using stairs, long rides and flights, limited menus, and not always with air conditioning. Adults need to keep these things in mind before choosing to make a journey.
